Santa Barbara, CA, November 7, 2024 – Lobero LIVE presents **Louden Wainwright III and Livingston Taylor on Thursday, December 5, 2024 at 7:30 PM**. Loudon Wainwright III has recorded 27 albums over the course of his career, including his 2009 GRAMMY® Award-winning *High Wide & Handsome*. Livingston Taylor maintains a performance schedule of more than a hundred shows a year, delighting audiences with his charm and vast repertoire of his 22 albums and popular classics.

Louden Wainwright III's songs have been recorded by Bonnie Raitt, Johnny Cash, Earl Scruggs, Kate & Anna McGarrigle, his son Rufus Wainwright, and Mose Allison, among others. In 2022, Wainwright released *Lifetime Achievement*, an album of 15 original songs, that established his singular talent as our foremost six-string tragicomedian, not only undiminished, but hitting new heights. Additionally, he has co-written with songwriter/producer Joe Henry on the music for Judd Apatow's hit movie *Knocked Up*, written music for the British theatrical adaptation of the Carl Hiaasen novel *Lucky You*, and composed topical songs for NPR's *Morning Edition* and *All Things Considered* and ABC's *Nightline*. An accomplished actor, he has appeared on TV, Broadway, and in numerous films directed by Martin Scorsese, Hal Ashby, Christopher Guest, Tim Burton, Cameron Crowe, and Judd Apatow.

Livingston Taylor's career as a professional musician has spanned over 50 years, encompassing performance, songwriting, and teaching. Livingston has written top 40 hits, recorded by his brother James Taylor, and has appeared with Joni Mitchell, Linda Ronstadt, Fleetwood Mac, and Jimmy Buffet. He is equally at home with a range of musical genres – folk, pop, gospel, jazz – and from upbeat storytelling and touching ballads to full orchestra performances. In addition to his performance schedule, Livingston has taught stage performance for over 30 years, beginning at Berklee College of Music in Boston in 1989, passing on the extensive knowledge gained from his long career on the road to the next generation of musicians.
