Santa Barbara, CA, January 23, 2025 – Lobero LIVE presents Rickie Lee Jones on Saturday, February 1, 2025 at 7:30 PM. Jones is the most iconic American female singer-songwriter of her time, a woman who outlasted all her adversaries, including youth and self-destruction. The talented musician, storyteller and two-time GRAMMY® winner has been inspiring pop culture for decades. A seasoned humility brings her performances an authenticity that only long-enduring musicians achieve.

In 2023, Rickie Lee released her GRAMMY® nominated album *Pieces of Treasure* (BMG Modern Recordings), a reunion with her lifelong friend, legendary producer Russ Titelman, co-producer of Jones' star-making self-titled debut and *Pirates*. Throughout her career, the singer-songwriter has interpreted an extraordinarily wide range of songs and has recorded celebrated jazz-leaning albums including *Girl at Her Volcano* and *Pop Pop* – but until now, she had never devoted an entire album to the American Songbook.

Rickie Lee Jones has been named the “premiere song-stylist and songwriter of her generation” by *The New Yorker*, and “The Duchess of Coolsville” by *Time* magazine. The artist’s celebrated memoir *Last Chance Texaco* was named Book of the Year by *MOJO* and a Best Book of the Year at *Pitchfork* and *NPR*. *The Independent* writes, “There has always been something defiant about Rickie Lee Jones... a voice from a dream, elusive yet familiar, transcendent, a messenger from another place.”
