## The Derek Douget Band

Santa Barbara, CA, March 4, 2025 – Jazz at the Lobero presents **The Derek Douget Band on Saturday, April 5, 2025 at 7:30 PM**. Accomplished saxophonist Derek Douget, who's served as Music Director of the Brubeck Circle Residency since 2018, returns to the Lobero stage for an electrifying performance not to be missed. His stellar band of world-renowned jazz musicians includes GRAMMY<sup>®</sup> Award-winner Victor "Red" Atkins, Trumpet Mafia leader Ashlin Parker, Jason Stewart (Ellis Marsalis Trio), and GRAMMY<sup>®</sup> Award-winning artist Adonis Rose (Artistic Director of New Orleans Jazz Orchestra).

**Derek Douget** finely mixes his Louisiana upbringing with his strong individualism and idiosyncratic voice. He was mentored by Ellis Marsalis and Harold Battiste, and studied under Ed Petersen at The University of New Orleans. He was later recruited for their graduate program and inaugural Louis Armstrong Quintet – a performing group of graduate students dedicated to teaching jazz in New Orleans area schools. By the time he graduated, Douget had toured nationally, recorded a movie soundtrack, and was a member of the Ellis Marsalis Quartet. After completing his Master's program, Derek moved to Brooklyn, NY and later became the Music Education Coordinator for the Don Jamison Heritage School of Music. Playing the alto and soprano saxophones, the artist has performed with many notable musicians on the New Orleans scene, including Nicolas Payton, Dr. John, Terence Blanchard, Allen Toussaint, Branford Marsalis, and countless others.

GRAMMY<sup>®</sup> Award-winner **Victor "Red" Atkins** has also worked with an impressive list of artists, including Elvin Jones, Freddie Hubbard, Aaron Neville, Dee Dee Bridgewater, and the Headhunters. He has performed at notable venues and well-known jazz festivals across the US and in Japan, France, and Spain. **Ashlin Parker** has played with numerous notable ensembles worldwide, as well as groups led by Roland Guerin, Adonis Rose, Derek Douget, and Leroy Jones. His solos have been described as being lyrical or fiery, with throaty growls or brilliant vibrato, and with lightning staccato runs or superb legato phrasing. Ashlin founded the Trumpet Mafia, which has international membership and a cult following.

Jason Stewart studied with master bassist Ron Carter, received an Artist Diploma from the Juilliard School of Music, then performed for a decade with the Ellis Marsalis trio, quartet, and quintet. He has also performed over the years with the Marsalis family, Leroy Jones, The New Orleans Jazz Orchestra, and various others. Adonis Rose is a GRAMMY<sup>®</sup> Award-winning artist, composer, educator, and producer from New Orleans. He has played and recorded with the biggest names in jazz and has performed on the most renowned stages in the world. As Artistic

Director of the New Orleans Jazz Orchestra, he is currently working on several new recordings with the orchestra and his own ensembles, and continues to tour, perform, and produce a range of projects.

#### The Brubeck Jazz Residency Program

As one of *Downbeat* magazine's Top Jazz Venues for more than a decade, the Lobero sits in a unique position to support future generations of jazz musicians. The Brubeck Jazz Residency Program consists of twelve hands-on workshops with more than 350 students in just five days. In residence March 31 - April 4, the program provides inclassroom jazz masterclasses throughout Santa Barbara. There will also be a student "jam session" open to all jazz music students from schools county-wide, followed by a public performance on the Lobero stage, for which all students are offered complimentary tickets. The true benefit of visiting the same schools with the same artists year-after-year is that we are building relationships and can follow the progress of the most engaged students.
